Calling all AHPs and healthcare scientists: launching the Advancing Healthcare awards 2018

Allied health professionals, healthcare scientists and those who work alongside them in support roles have until 19 January 2018 to enter the Advancing Healthcare Awards, the unique awards programme which crosses boundaries and fosters partnership working.

This year we have four new awards. The Chroma award for realising potential through creativity, the Viapath award for innovation in healthcare science, the IBMS award for inspiring the biomedical workforce of the future and the Biomedical Scientist of the Year award, sponsored by Health Services Laboratories.
